**NOW**, on this 3rd day of September, 1959, the **Commission**, a quorum being **present**, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by **law**, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, United States Borax & Chemical **Corporation**, is the owner of certain potash leases in Townships 21 and 22 South, Ranges 29 and 30 East, **NMPM**, Eddy **County**, New Mexico.

(3) That the applicant seeks an amendment of Order No. R-111-A to extend the Potash-Oil Area as set forth in said order to include the following described acreage:


