ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION;

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on April 25, 1962, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvis A. Utz, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 8th day of May, 1962, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Elvis A. Utz, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Amerada Petroleum Corporation, seeks permission to institute a pressure maintenance project in that portion of the Saunders Permo-Pennsylvanian Pool underlying the S/2 S/2 of Section 3 and the N/2 of Section 10, Township 15 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, with the injection of water into the Pennsylvanian formation initially to be through the Amerada State "S-E" Well No. 1, located in Unit C of said Section 10.
- (3) That no special rules or regulations governing said project are requested at this time.
- (4) That approval of the subject application will neither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Amerada Petroleum Corporation is hereby authorized to institute a pressure maintenance project in that portion of the

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Saunders Permo-Pennsylvanian Pool underlying the S/2 S/2 of Section 3 and the N/2 of Section 10, Township 15 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, with the injection of water into the Pennsylvanian formation initially through the Amerada State "S-E" Well No. 1, located in Unit C of said Section 10.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary,
