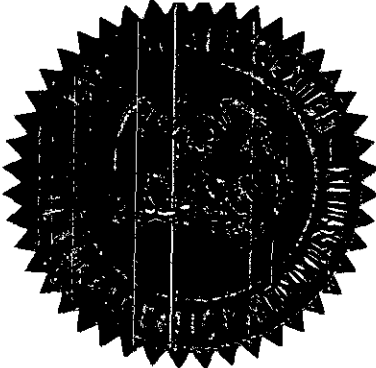
**ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY STAY OF ORDER NO. R-12649**

THIS MATTER, having come before the Chair of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on Travelers Indemnity Company and Tempo Energy, Inc.'s motion requesting a temporary stay of Order No. R-12659 directing Tempo Energy, Inc. to plug and abandon the San Simon State Well No. 6 and ordering the forfeiture of Blanket Plugging Bond No. 980F9999 pending the Oil Conservation Commission's final action in this matter; Tempo Energy, Inc. asserting that it has not owned an interest in the lands dedicated to the subject well and has not received a benefit from them and has not authorized the use of its Blanket Plugging Bond or operator OGRID number by any third part; and Division counsel having concurred with the motion, the Chair hereby grants the motion to temporarily stay Order No. R-12659 pending the Oil Conservation Commission's final action in this matter.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

Order No. R-12659 is temporarily stayed until the Oil Conservation Commission's final action in this matter.
