BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing that Ordering Paragraphs (3) and (4) of Order No. R-12835 contain typographical errors,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- (1) Paragraphs (3) and (4) of this order are hereby amended to read in their entirety as follows:
 - (3) The operator of the Unit shall commence re-entering the proposed well on or before February 10, 2008 and shall thereafter continue drilling the well with due diligence to test the Wolfcamp formation.
 - (4) In the event the operator does not commence re-entering the proposed well on or before February 10, 2008, Ordering Paragraph (1) shall be of no effect, unless the operator obtains a time extension from the Division Director for good cause.
- (2) The corrections set forth in this order shall be entered retroactively as of October 26, 2007.
- (3) All other provisions of Division Order No. R-12835 shall remain in full force and effect.
- (4) Jurisdiction is retained for the entry of such further orders as may be necessary.
