NOW, on this 20<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2009, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner,

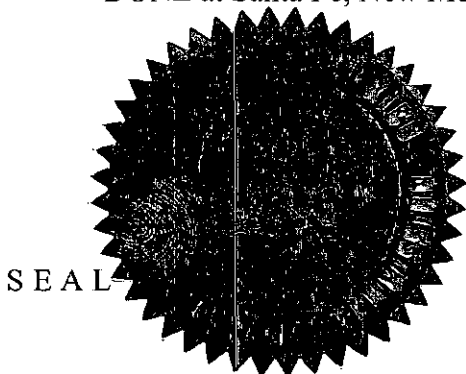
**FINDS THAT:**
