FINDS THAT:

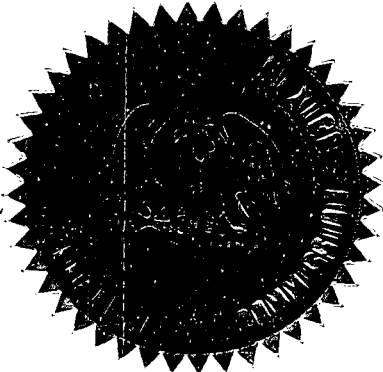
De Novo Case No. 10693 should be dismissed for want of prosecution.
