Good Morning Ed,

Hope your holidays were good here is some info on inactive wells we will be getting with engineer in couple of weeks and send you more updated info on this wells.

A-18: waiting on new water line.

B-163: well is turned back on. Currently selling 15 mcf, the pumping unit is down stacked out. One of those we haven't pulled because of economics. Atlas will need to make a decision.

B-220: is up for plugging.

B-221: Stacked out not fixed for economic reasons.

D-120: Well needs worked over. Also need a new pumping unit, has not been fixed because of economic reasons. Atlas will need to review for recommendations.

✓ D-155: Pumping unit is shut down well makes a lot of water and no gas. According to records from 3-30-2013 to 4-30-2013 it produced 530 bbls per day. Never has made over 3 mcf, down because of economic reasons

D-157: Pumping unit is shut down. 3-30-2013 to 4-30-2013 it made 90 bbl per day and no gas, down because of economic reasons

D-162: Pumping unit is shut down. Well has always made a lot of water and no gas. In March we pumped it for 1 week and made 310 bbl a day and no gas, down because of economic reasons
