### Good afternoon, Amithy!

I've finished the paying well determinations for both of the subject wells. You should be receiving a letter in the next week or so showing the 16H is a paying well, and we will need an Initial Bone Spring Formation PA "A" Application sent to us (Effective date will be August 28, 2018). You'll have until May 24th to submit this, but feel free to submit it earlier if you like. The boundary will simply be the same as the well acreage dedication established by the NMOCD (attached document).

I did look at the economics on the 17H, and absolutely agree its a paying well. But once I started drafting the paying well letter, I realized there's already a Wolfcamp PA "A", and the 17H is clearly within the boundaries of this existing PA (this was also shown on the colorful plat you included with the PWD request). Due to this, you won't need anything from us to form a new boundary or anything. We will update our database showing this well is in the PA, and you shouldn't have any trouble reporting production for the 17H to the Wolfcamp PA "A" (NMNM071019B).
