WC-025 G-09 S263504N;WOLFCAMP	(98117)


The well is located in Section 6, Township 26 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The WC-025 G-08 S253534O;BONE SPRING pool (97088) shall be allocated ninety three (93) percent of the total oil produced and ninety four (94) percent of the total gas produced from the Charlie Murphy 6 TB Federal Com 14H well (30-025-46484).

The WC-025 G-09 S263504N;WOLFCAMP pool (98117) shall be allocated seven (7) percent of the total oil produced and six (6) percent of the total gas produced from the Charlie Murphy 6 TB Federal Com 14H well (30-025-46484).

Pursuant to Division Rule 19.15.12.11(B) NMAC, the commingling authority granted herein may be rescinded by the Division Director if conservation is not being best served by such commingling.

This approval is subject to like approval from the Bureau of Land Management.
