In response to your letter of May 27, 1983 to the referenced well above the State of New Mexico Oil Conservation Divison would recommend the following plugging program:

5 sx.cement @ surface with regulation dry hole marker

25 sx. cement in and out of the base of the surface casing { with dvlg 30 sx. cement @ 420' 25 sx. cement @ T.D. (1000!)

× 30 sx. cement @ 420'

25 sx.cement @ T.D. (1000')

A review of your file on the subject well has also indicated that we are lacking a Form C-105, that Form and an instruction sheet is enclosed. The Oil Conservation Division will have a Field representative in the Tucumari area on Thursday afternoon's and Friday mornings on a regular basis and if possible it would be appreciated if this well could be plugged at this time.
