Dear Sir:

In regard to your Form C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill, Silverstein-Ulmer #1, 329.3 N of S line, 328.0 W of Center $\frac{1}{4}$ line (it would be preferable to state distance from nearest section line or 2293.5 E of W section line).

You will remember that we questioned the location as being unorthodox by a few feet. In order to take care of this in our records we would like to request you to relocate the well bore 5 ft. north and 5 ft. west, which will make your location orthodox, as our statewide spacing rule specifies a minimum of 330 ft. from a 40-acre boundary. An affidavit to this effect should be filed with us.

This would make your location read as follows:

333 ft. N of S section line, 2288.5 ft. E of W section line, Section 11, Township 12N, Range 32E.

Your cooperation in this matter will be appreciated. This and receipt of your plugging bond will allow us to approve your Notice of Intention to Drill.
