

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 39 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: \$75,000.00 Cash + Bond Form 30-11.

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

Table with 7 columns: Size of Hole, Size of Casing, Weight Per Foot, New or Second Hand, Depth, Landed or Cemented, Sacks Cement. It lists two casing strings: one 2 1/2 inch hole with 2 1/2 inch casing, 40 lb weight, 640 feet depth, landed; and another 2 1/2 inch hole with 2 1/2 inch casing, 32 lb weight, 1700 feet depth, cemented with 50 sacks.

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 1000 feet.


