Following the twisting off as reported on the previous report the fish of thirteen drill collars, two joints of drill pipe and the rock bit was engaged with an overshot and pulled on July 4. An electric survey of the hole was run by Lane-Wells. This survey measured bottom at 6127' compared to the driller's total depth of 6128'.

On July 6, the well was plugged as follows:

First plug	10	sacks	cement	at	3126'
Second plug	12	sacks	cement	at	1898'
Third plug	12	11	11	11	327'

(bottom of surface casing) Fourth plug · 10 sacks cement at surface (3" pipe as marker in latter)

The drill pipe is broken down and stacked on the location and the derrick, drawworks and mud pumps are still in place at the well site.
