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Total depth at this well today has reached 5885' and drilling is progressing satisfactorily. Formation encountered here is a re-worked granite or granite wash material. This is now being drilled with 7 7/8" W7R rock bits, although the new Hughes R-1 bit has been used up the hole to good advantage.

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There is a great deal of red shale cavings in the cuttings. Ditch samples of the interval 5615-5880' were delivered to me for transfer to the state sample library.

one piece of debris with 1/8" #35 rock pile, scrapings the
