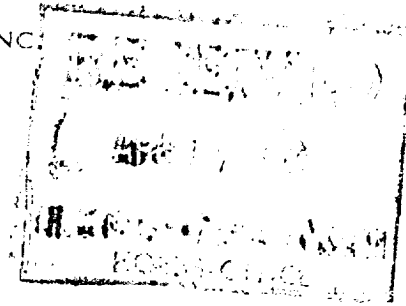

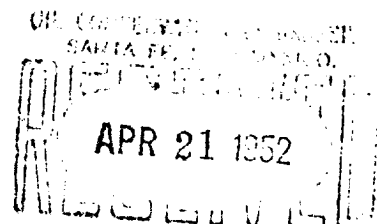

INSPECTION REPORT

October 17, 1951

Tippens-Hamill - #1 NWNW - Section 35-12N-34E -Quay County.

This location was inspected the day after it was plugged.
The rig was being torn down to move off the location. The
plugging job as represented and as inspected was satisfactory.
The total depth was 5615'. It was described as bottom corecite.
Surface casing was set at 340' and 25 sacks cement plugging
was put from 330' to 350'. A 10 sacks was put in top of casing
and 4"x4' steel marker was welded on top of surface casing.
Pending receipt of samples, plugging bond on this well can be
released.
