Dear Sir:

We have received a notice of intention to convert a well which we presume is the well known as George L. Harris, McFarland No. 1 in the NE/4 NE/4 NW/4 section 3, T.13 N, R.33 E. Your notice gave no other information than that the well was located in section 2 and the township and range.

The only way in which your \$2,500 bond with the National Surety Corporation may be cancelled is for the well to be plugged back to the water in the prescribed manner and for the landowner to accept full responsibility for the plugging of this well when it is no longer used as a water well.

If Mr. McFarland is in agreement, please have him sign the form C-102 to convert the well to a water well and have him sign the form C-103 before a notary, assuring the Commission that he will accept full responsibility for the plugging of this well to comply with Commission regulations.

In the event Mr. McFarland does not wish to accept the responsibility for this well, it will be necessary for you to plug the well yourself to the satisfaction of the Oil Conservation Commission before the Commission has the authority to cancel your bond.
