The total depth at the above captioned well is 2997'. No additional  
footage has been made during the previous week as the well continued  
making an increasing amount of water regardless of the manner by  
which it was bailed dry as stated in my last report. Apparently the  
water level rose considerably while the well was shut down overnight.  
Actually the water rose 100' in one hour following bailing dry operations  
but did not seek its old level. Halliburton has suggested a 50 pack  
cement squeeze similar to the previous job but the operator is skeptical  
as to its practicability, fearing that this much cement may channel up  
the 6" annulus containing approximately 1500' of casing.

Presently the well is shut down due to an abnormal rainstorm of last  
night. This rain left the lease, an old lake bed, very well flooded to  
the level of the rig floor.

P  
Mr. David Ross intends to abandon operations for a period of 30 - 60 days.  
Upon resumption of work he plans to try a small cement squeeze job in a  
final effort to dry up the hole. If this fails he may abandon the well  
permanently.
