The 5¹/₂ casing in this well had been lowered to 2022 but the well continued to make water from below the casing. Consequently a cement squeeze was made on July 23 by Halliburton Cementing Co. Data on this job is as follows:

> squeezed 10 sacks Portland with HOWCO truck (2527 from Terrors, 5)" new casing at 2012', TD 2000', this mixing losin., time purping 2 hr. 50min., casent left in esg. 5', top of cement 2077', homemade plug set at approximately 2836'.

The cenent was allowed to set for 72 hours. Then the hole was cleaned out and drilling resured. No coment was encountered below the 5' plug left inside the casing. The well was deepened to 2997'. This seven feet was made in 30 to 40 minutes and formation here was a brown shule. The hole is still raking water and today approximately 600 gallons were balled in 12 hours after which the well was dry.

The operator now plans to deepen as long as he can keep ahead of the water level.
