This well is presently shut down temporarily at 2990'. The formation here as previously reported is sandy shale with traces of granite wash.

A Lane Well's gamma ray survey had been anticipated by the operator but financial aid by offset lessees was not realized so this move was abandoned.

The well was swabbed through the $5 1/2^{11}$ casing which reaches 2815' in an attempt to lower the water level.

The latter was lowered 200^t but it rose 500^t from bottom after swabbing. The Salt water swabbed continued to show meager traces of dead-oil scum. The operator now plans to resume activity after January 1, 1953.
