Dear Ms. Kemp:

This letter is to inform you (again) that this office is still in a state of bewilderment on the ownership and status of the above-referenced well.

On July 26, 1982, this office received your letter of March 3, 1982 to CO₂-In-Action stating that they owned the above-referenced well. Not having any response from CO₂-In-Action on filing the appropriate forms with this office, a forced plugging case was set for September 15, 1982. In response to this case a Form C-103 was filed by CO₂-In-Action requesting a Temporary Abandonment Status due to "pending title clearance litigations and possible completion attempts." This Temporary Abandonment Status has expired on September 15, 1983, and any extension of this status must be approved by the Division Director at this office.

On February 3, 1983, this office received notice of plugging and abandonment from Sun Exploration and Production Co. on this well and a recent field inspection on October 13, 1983, revealed that the well has not been plugged and this location has not been reclaimed.

If this well is to be plugged and abandoned, please notify this office as to an approximate date that work will start. If an extension for Temporary Abandonment Status is desired, please address your request to Mr. Joe D. Ramey,
