## INSPECTION REPORT

This well was plugged and abandoned dry on July 22, 1952. Schlumberger logged the well electrically and found total depth to be 3113'. Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company did the plugging which was as tollows: 50 sacks El Toro Portland cement pumped down to 400' with 300 p.s.i. circulating and maximum pump pressures and a conventional "HOWCO" rubber-composition plug 22 sacks same cement pumped down to 170' with similar pump pressures.

A surface plug and regulation marker will be placed in the abandoned hole, the premises will be cleaned up and the mud pits temporarily fenced pending drying and levelling of same.

The drilling equipment has been moved to the new location approximately 10 miles east of the abandoned well and is being immediately rigged up.
