This well at noon today has reached a total depth of 663' and drilling is continuing in a red shale.

Following last week's cementing of the surface casing drilling was resumed on August 2. For the most part, drilling in the Glorietta formation has been slow and was done with W7, W7R and OWC rock bits. A total of thirteen bits have been used to reach the present total depth.

The last of the Glorietta was apparently passed at 630-640', at which interval a red shale began to predominate.

Circulation was lost for half an hour around 400' and was regained after addition of five sacks of cottonseed hulls and four of crevice-seal. It was again lost at 442' and a continuous addition of bulk material has been necessary from this depth to today's total depth.
