The well location should also be marked as being in Unit "A", both in the written description and in the small plat on the C-101.

We also failed to insert the following statement in the exception space below the approval date on the C-101: "Collect and sack samples for New Mexico Bureau of Mines, Socorro, at at least ten feet intervals."

Please make the above described changes in your copies of the Notice of Intention to Drill.

The cuttings samples may be saved and mailed to the Bureau of Mines at Socorro upon completion of the well.
