P Gentlemen:

Y Reference is made to your letter of August 23, 1960 requesting the subject well be classified as a shut-in gas well. Gas tests accompanying the request indicate the well is incapable of producing gas in commercially paying quantities therefore, the requested classification cannot be granted.

Although the ownership of the well in question has been transferred to Ledge Petroleum Company it is noted that persons involved remains the same. Temporary abandonment status of Sedberry Well No. 1 was extended to September 1, 1960 contingent upon your drilling a second well in the area, drilling to have been started on or before June 1, 1960. On April 24, 1959, October 15, 1959 and again on April 8, 1960 you requested temporary abandonment status for Sedberry #1 for the same reason, "until the drilling of the second well can be completed."

Since the drilling of the second well has not transpired the Commission would appreciate knowing just what your intentions are for the future disposition of the subject well before taking further action on the matter.
