Enclosed are 3 copies of our one-well bond forms - as you requested by telephone today. Also enclosed are 5 copies of our Form C-101 and a brief summary of rules for drilling oil/gas wells in New Mexico.

With respect to the Form C-102, a copy of that form (signed by the surveyor) from the well file will suffice; that is, no new survey is needed for re-entry of an existing well.

If and when you begin operations, the additional forms needed will be furnished you. If you operate as a corporation, you must be licensed by the State Corporation Commission to get your bond approved.

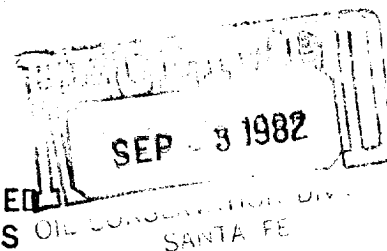

Original hole had 400' of 10" casing cemented with 200 sacks of cement and was plugged 7/24/74. We propose to re-enter hole and deepen to Pennsylvanian approximate depth of 3500'. Proposal is to use 7 5/8" surface pipe for 1st 500 feet and 4 1/2" pipe balance to bottom. Well is to be drilled for Geological information, but will be completed and produced if economical discovery is made. Otherwise will be plugged as required.

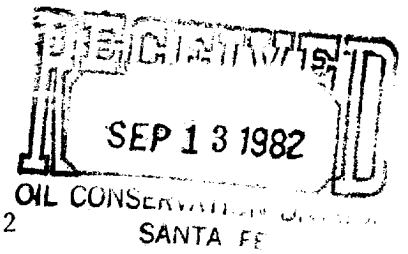
