Enclosed are copies of the blank forms which you will need to complete when you begin operations at the Horton Well No. 1, located in the northeast corner of Section 32, Township 11 North, Range 7 East, NMPM, Santa Fe County. As discussed in our telephone conversation on March 25, 1975, it will be necessary for a bond to be posted in the name of the new operator, either by transfer of the existing bond or acquisition of a new bond. Forms are enclosed for this purpose. In the event you should decide to assign the well to Mr. Horton for use as a water supply well, you note that the proper forms for such a transfer are also enclosed.

If you are not familiar with State regulations concerning wells drilled for oil or gas, I am sending copies of the most important rules. If you encounter production, there are other rules that will apply and also other forms which you will need. These will be furnished upon request.

Because of the time which has elapsed since the subject well was abandoned, it will be required that some type of action be taken before May 15, 1975.
