A-32-11N-7E (1 well): Investigate conditions at site of drilling (initially non-permitted) where operations began approximately 2/5/83. Location apparently abandoned, casing open at surface, pits open, some equipment at site, but rig gone. Landowner reported depth to be $\pm 3000'$ and that operator indicated another rig to be brought in for deepening. (Eastern Sandia)
