SUBJECT: Pinon Unit #2 Reclamation

I am writing this letter in order to get a clarification of what Chace Oil Company should do with our reserve pit and associated clean up on the Pinon Unit #2 well located in Santa Fe County. The problem arises due to a local landowners' agreement whereby Chace Oil Company agreed to haul off all reserve pit material, including pit liner, to a nearby county dump provided all state and federal authorities agreed to this transporting of the pit material. The local landowners association also forced Chace Oil Company to use a pit liner which is still in place and seems to be working fine to hold all material in place within the pit.

The problem to be resolved is whether or not the State Oil Conservation Division would like to have us bury the material as is or move all the pit material to the county dump. The reason the local landowners association were so concerned is because the area water table is only about 30 feet or so in the area.

Please advise us as soon as possible in writing as to what course of action we can take. Thank you.


