Dear Mr. Ramey:

Shown on the attached plat is the location of a proposed test well located approximately 30 miles northwest of Magdalena, New Mexico. Also shown are the locations of one deep oil and gas test drilled by TransOcean Oil Company and two shallow core holes drilled to test for other minerals which bottomed in the San Andres Formation.

Our proposed total depth is approximately 1500 feet in the Dakota Formation. Inasmuch as these tests encountered no abnormal pressures through the depths and formations which we propose to test, we request approval to waive the requirement for blowout prevention equipment on this test well. We plan to set 30 feet of 7" surface casing.


