This is to advise that we are in receipt of the requested rider to attach to the bond covering the subject wells and have this date approved the transfer of your Sanchez No. 2 to Mr. Antonio F. Sanchez for his use as a water-well. The bond rider releases the surety company's liability for this well, but continues their liability for the Sanchez No. 2-A, located 1990' FWL and 3350' FNL of Section 23, Township 2 North, Range 4 East.

We are enclosing one approved copy of your Report of Transfer of Ownership of Sanchez No. 2 and Notice of Intention to Drill Sanchez No. 2-A. Please note that the approval of the transfer has been conditioned upon compliance with properly plugging the well back to just below the fresh water sand pursuant to Oil Conservation Commission Rule R-203.

As per our telegram of this date, the shut-down order placed on your Sanchez No. 2-A at 1:45 P.M., May 4, 1955, is hereby rescinded and you may resume operations at any time.
