This letter is to inform you that we have received your water-well conversion forms on the above-referenced wells.

In reviewing your well files, it has been determined that you are lacking the required data and forms before these water-well conversions can be approved. In your Norman wells, no forms C-103 and C-105's have been received by this agency. A copy of electric logs are required on these wells also.

On your Formwalt well, this agency needs a Form C-103 stating pertinent data as required by our Rules and Regulations. For your convenience I have enclosed instruction sheets for these forms. This data must be filed before the bond on these wells can be released.

Since these wells have been in a state of "limbo" for the past 1 1/2 years, your prompt action would be greatly appreciated.
