Dear Mr. Aday:

It is this office's understanding that the above-referenced well was originally drilled as a water well and that your past operations have deepened this well to test for oil and gas potential. Your Sundry Notice has indicated that the well was deepened 555 feet, 4 1/2-inch casing was set at 1264 feet and a cement plug was set at 1280 feet. The minimum plugging requirement on this well would therefore consist of placing 40 sacks of cement at the top of your existing cement plug at 1280 feet. This 40-sack plug would then fill the open hole section (1269'-1280') and bring the cement up into the 4 1/2' casing. This operation may be done by running tubing and pumping cement or by using a dump bailer.

The enclosed forms will need to be filled out completely in order to close out this well file. Should you have any questions, please contact me at this office.
