I have been advised by Mr. L. V. Fitzwater, our contractor that Harry Lemmons owner of this land is very anxious that we arrange to let him use this well for stock well as water is very scarce in this section of the country. This well is an excellent water well with no shows of oil or gas.

Please advise if this can be arranged and if so we will deliver the well to Mr. Harry Lemmons. Also if this is agreeable, please release our bond in the amount of \$2500.00.
