INSPECTION REPORT

July 25, 1951

Mountainair Oil and Gas Well #1
NESE Sec. 31, 4N, 7E.
Torrance County

This well was inspected July 25, 1951, and the following is recorded:

Arriving at the location I found that operations were in progress. Mr. Frank Rylant, who says he owns about a half interest in the well, was using cable tool rig to clean out the hole. We had not been notified of this operation. In conversing with Mr. Rylant, he agreed to get our Forms and make current reports as well as to get the old reports up to date, which was done Monday July 30, by Mr. H. Walpole who is the secretary of the Mountainair Oil and Gas Company, Mountainair, New Mexico. Both Walpole and Rylant stated that the bond was paid up and that Jack Daniels was now willing to continue carrying the bond.

Their last report dated July 28, 1951, Form C-103, states that they were cleaning out the hole to 3104 ft., fishing for tools after cave-in. The surface casing was set at 110 ft., 8 5/8ths OD circulated with 200 sacks. Five and a half inch set at 2426 ft. with approximately 200 sacks according to Mr. Rylant. The amount of cement used does not show on the Form. They further report that the Schlumberger J Picture shows a pay at 2485 ft., 2600 ft., and 2885 ft.
