Reference is made to your letter of April 4, 1960,  
regarding the above-captioned subject wherein you state  
that Miss Jane Clack has plugged the subject well.

When an operator is arranging to plug a well, it is  
customary to submit Commission Form C-102 outlining a  
proposed plugging program which is then approved, or if  
necessary modified, by our District Engineer. After the  
well is plugged, it is necessary that 3 copies of our  
Form C-103 be submitted showing the actual work that was  
done. Our District Engineer then makes a field inspection  
of the location and, if everything is in good order, the  
plugging bond is cancelled and the well file closed.

Since the subject well has apparently already been  
plugged, it will be necessary to dispense with Step No. 1  
(filing a proposed plugging program). It will be necessary  
that Miss Clack file 3 copies of Form C-103, which I have  
enclosed, outlining how the well was plugged. If a

I represent Mr. W. L. Cacy and Miss Jane Clack to whom you addressed a certain letter on November 19 pertaining to:


W. L. Cacy, Cacy Well
