(Cacy Well No. 1-A, Unit H, Section 23,
Township 6 North, Range 5 East, Torrance
County, New Mexico)

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of December 24, 1959,
concerning the above captioned bond.

Mr. Cacy abandoned the subject well in 1956 without
getting approval of the Oil Conservation Commission to tempo-
rarily abandon it and without doing the work that is required
when a well is temporarily abandoned.

Inasmuch as the well has been inactive since 1956, it
must now be permanently plugged in accordance with Commission
Rules and Regulations. It is quite obvious that Mr. Cacy does
not intend to do this work of his own volition. Consequently,
we now make a firm and formal demand that your Company, as
surety on the bond for the subject well, arrange to have the
well properly plugged no later than May 15, 1960.

Since the principal has failed to file the required forms
on the subject well, the only acceptable plugging program is to
fill the hole with cement from bottom to top.
