Dear Mr. Cacy:

This office has received no report on the subject well subsequent to the approval of its nonstandard location January 12, 1956. It has been noted from the Southeast New Mexico Scout Report that the well was drilled to a total depth of 955 feet and has been sitting idle for a considerable period of time.

I now call your attention to Rule 202, paragraph (c), Commission Rules and Regulations, which states, "When drilling operations have been suspended for 60 days, the well shall be plugged and abandoned unless a permit for temporary abandonment shall be obtained from the Commission." Therefore, I am sending you, herewith, 3 copies of Form C-102 which may be used for either request for temporary abandonment or Notice of Intention to Plug. If you request temporary abandonment be sure to specify a period of time and give your reasons for the request.

Your immediate attention to this matter will be appreciated.
