
Dear Sirs:

I hand you herewith Notice of Intention to Drill, in quintuplicate, an oil and gas test well in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, T6N, R5E, N.M.P.M.

The undersigned owns the federal oil and gas lease on the lands immediately east of the location and owns the fee title in the lands immediately south of the location, and thus controls by ownership or lease the lands within 660 feet of the proposed location in all directions.

The unorthodox location is on account of the fact that a well was recently drilled in the center of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ in said Section 23 to a depth of 550 feet and designated as Cacy and Overmier No. 1. Said well was plugged and in order to safely drill on or near the same location, it was necessary to move the proposed location to a distance of 171 feet south of the old hole.
