(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Previously set 60' of 8 5/8" surface casing @ 60' with 30 sacks cement about December 20, 1954. Then about February 4, 1955 set 485' of 4" line pipe @ 485' with 65 sacks. Total depth of 575'. Plugged back with cement to 520'. Acidized open hole with 1000 gallons. 4" pipe failed @ 100'. Squeezed in bradenhead to surface. Remainder of samples will be furnished to the Commission.

Propose to plug well by spotting 10 sacks cement in bottom of hole to bring cement into 4" pipe. Then spot 10 sacks cement plug at top of well. Place usual 4" marker 4' above ground level and abandon well.
