The above captioned well has today reached a total depth of 482'. Drilling for the past week has progressed uninterrupted at a rate of approximately seven feet per day. The formation here is a tan to buff to white limestone with minor traces of brown to gray brown sand. A nine inch stringer of black carbonaceous shale was found at 465' and a one foot vein of maroon and green variegated shale at 473'.

This hole still is uncased from the surface to total depth and is holding up satisfactorily.
