Thank you very much for your letter of November 16, 1967, along with the attachments of copies of the Bonds involved in the above captioned matter.

Please be advised that we have been successful in determining through what agency these Bonds were written. We find that it was an out of state Bonding agency and that the Bonds were merely counter-signed through a local Hartford agent doing business in the state of New Mexico. In any event, it has been determined that these Bonds were written through the Worsham and Associates, Incorporated, of 3821 Long Beach Boulevarde, Long Beach, California. Apparently the James Russell Agency in Santa Fe were the countersigners for these Bonds, and this is whyyour information was so limited at the time you first put us on notice.

I am, at this time, writing for Certification of Coverage and the proper insurance information needed to correct this situation.

As soon as I hear from our agent in California, I will notify your office.

I wish to thank you at this time for your co-operation and assistance in this matter.
