Dear Mr. Pollard:

In reply to your letter requesting forms and information leading to the cancellation of the drilling bond covering the subject wells, we are sending you with this letter, several copies of the appropriate forms with a sheet of pertinent instructions.

We have checked our files on these wells and found that only the C-10 and the C-128 have been filed on the Sewell Well and that a C-101, -128 and a change of ownership have been filed on the Moore and Mead well. It will be necessary for you to file a form, for each well reporting the date drilling was actually commenced and the results of casing shut off tests for each string of casing run, and a C-103 giving the status of the Moore and Mead well at the time it was transferred to Anderson and Woodson Exploration Company. The Form C-1 (outlining a satisfactory plugging program, must be filed even if this well has already been plugged and further, a complete record of the actual plugging operation must be reported on Form C-10.

After this office receives these forms and an inspection is made of the site, we may release your bond provided that the well, Sewell No. 1 has been properly plugged.
