

M-30-8N-8E: Pollard Bros., Moore & Mead Well No. 1; from F-10N-5E to well ten miles southwest of Moriarity apparently drilled between January 1956 and June 1958. Notice of Intention to Drill filed by Pollard 12/30/55. Form C-103 transferring ownership to J. L. Anderson and Woodson Exploration Co. 8/16/56. Note in file from O.C.C. Attorney Cooley states well was converted to water well and transferred to Mr. Mead (Mead's Fine Bread). No Affidavit of Responsibility filed, no completion reports submitted. Well was located and examined. No road within one mile of well site. Well appears to have been temporarily abandoned. Location is clean, level and revegetated. There is no identification. Also, surface casing appears to be 5 1/2" pipe with threaded collar and a removable 3' bull-plug.

There is no indication that well has been used for water supply, although there is fluid standing within casing at considerable depth. Bond is still in effect. 7/23/74

M-30-8N-8E: From above to oil/gas test abandoned approximately 1958. Last report filed by operator (Anderson & Woodson) indicated well would be released to landowner (Mead) for water supply use but no forms or other substantiation provided that such action was taken. New owner of land visited and joint inspection of location made. Water found to be at approximately 80' from surface. State regulations concerning such wells were explained to rancher and forms provided him for takeover of well for water supply purpose. Unless landowner's lawyer advises him to the contrary, he will probably accept well in present condition for water supply purpose. *CLL - 6/14/76*
