AFFIDAVIT OF RESPONSIBILITY - ABSENTEE OPERATOR  
CONVERSION TO WATER-WELL

Stanley E. Crowder, being first duly sworn according to law, upon his oath deposes and says:

1. That he is the owner of certain properties upon which Pollard Brothers (Name of Operator) whose address is Unknown drilled a well to test for hydrocarbons and/or carbon dioxide gas and said well is described as the Moore and Mead No. 1, being located 660 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the west line of Section 30, Township 8 North, Range 8 East, NMPM, Torrance County, New Mexico.

2. That said well was drilled to a total depth of 1025 feet, and that casing has been set and cemented as follows:

5 1/2" at Unknown Depth

3. That the present whereabouts of the operator is not known to the landowner and that it is the desire of the landowner to have the above described well transferred to him for conversion to his use as a water well. The landowner will leave casing in the well as follows:

As presently equipped if satisfactory for use as water supply well.

4. That when the landowner has converted said well in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 3 above he will so notify the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico on Commission Form C-103.
