FRANK BIGBEE the well known officially as Umbarger State No. 1, located in Section 3, T. 8 N., R. 14 E., in Torrance County, New Mexico, for use by Mr. Bigbee as a water well.

F. B. Umbarger certifies that the hole is cased with four inch (4") casing to a depth of not less than 2,260 feet and that same has been cemented below that point, and that any and all possible gas and oil zones have been properly protected.

All equipment that is now on the property above the ground is to be removed by F. B. Umbarger, and ^{THE} Mr. Bigbee accepts same in its present condition, including all casing in the hole, which shall remain as his property.
