Dear Mr. Kemmling:

Your letter dated January 2, 1980, requesting cancellation of the above-referenced bond has been received by this office. At this time, we are still unable to release the bond since the well covered by the bond has not been properly plugged and abandoned, or the bonding for the well replaced by another company, or transfer of the well to a properly bonded person or persons.

At this time the well has been temporarily abandoned for a period of ninety days which expires on or about January 18, 1980, at which time our district supervisor will be monitoring future decisions by the operator regarding the well.
