On this date I visited with Mr. J. B. Turner, a partner with Richard L. Nunn & Company who is acting as superintendent in charge of drilling operations at the above captioned well. This visit was in Clayton, New Mexico. The well's location is about 18 miles south of Clayton and 1/4 mile east of State Highway 18. The rig is a very small cable tool spudder.

The well is down to a total of 968', this depth having been reached with a 7 3/4" bit. Eight inch casing has been run and is hanging free with no seat at 580'. Present plans are to pull out the 8" string and run 6 1/4" I.D., 17# used casing and seat same at 968'. An underdigger will be used while running the reduced size casing string if the hole has any tight places. Mr. Turner is stocking 1950' of the 6 1/4" casing in the event the well has to be deepened to effect a good seat.

The operators intend to drill to a final depth of approximately 1200'.
