I have just had a report from the driller who pulled a portion of the 8" casing in the above well.

He got out 371 feet, and let the remainder, about 20 feet drop back into the well.

I have also talked to the land owner, and he is willing to accept the well "as is" for a water well, and the driller says it will be much better for that purpose without being filled part way, as there is so much sand both above and below where they struck the 235 ft. strata of water bearing sand.

This will leave the 290 ft. of 10" casing, and about 206 ft. of the 8" in the well.

If this is satisfactory with you, and if you will send the papers for the land owner and Mr. Nunn to sign, I will get them signed promptly.
