Dear Mr. Chavez:

Both Mrs Turner and I enjoyed your visit in Clayton.

When I left you to **go** down to Amarillo with my Geologist, I was taken ill and confined to bed for six days there. I returned to Clayton and am just now beginning to feel better. My field man was out of town so nothing could be done about the samples we discussed and the log of the well that you requested. They will, however, be forwarded to you tomorrow from Amarillo.

The casing for the Hopson well which was being checked during my illness was found to be thirteen pound weight. You realize, of course, that for our purpose a heavier weight is required. We are now securing nineteen pound casing which will be on the ground next Monday and actual operations continued at that time.

We are negotiating a contract tomorrow with the Frazier Drilling Co. to complete our well at Amstead. He has just finished a well in Texas and should have his rig set up at our well within the next ten days. Our biggest concern of course, as you know, is getting the water cut off at the Hopson Well.
