We have your C-103 (Report on Setting Casing) on
this well but your account of work done is not complete. Please
submit this report again, indicating if the 8-inch string was
cemented or landed; how much cement was used; and if you get
a satisfactory water shut-off. The latter is of the most con-
cern to us, as all potable water zones must be isolated to ward
off future contamination by lower salt waters.

I assume that you have reduced the hole below the
8-inch casing. However, you may be underdigging with intentions
to lower the 8-inch string. Please specify how you are pro-
ceeding.
